BEFORE THE MOVE



GIVE PETS EXTRA ATTENTION

This will assure them they are still being cared for.



PACK OVER SEVERAL WEEKS

Pets get nervous when items are packed away. Start with rooms they don't frequent and do your best to keep boxes out of sight.



VISIT A VET

Make sure your records are up to date and that you have updated your ID tags. It is always a good idea to microchip your pet in case he/she gets lost.



PLAN THE MOVE

Regardless of how far you relocate, always research the area and have a plan. From breed regulations to packing a pet overnight bag, make a plan and stick to it. If you are uneasy, they will be, too.

INTRODUCE YOUR PET TO THE MOVERS

Animals can be territorial of their home. Give them time to get to know the movers to reduce the chance of an issue.



ASSIGN SOMEONE TO CARE FOR THE PETS

It is best to have someone paying attention to the animals in the house. Blocking them in an area is also a good suggestion for safety reasons.



MAKE ROOM

Make sure to leave a comfortable amount of space in your packed car to transport the animal safely. Overcrowding may cause the animal to become stressed.

Please note: Introducing your animal slowly to their new environment is essential. Too much stress on an animal can cause unnecessary risk to their health.
